MONTEREY COUNTY SUBDIVISION/MINOR SUBDIVISION COMMITTEE September 9, 2004 MINUTES

The Monterey County Subdivision/Minor Subdivision Committee met at 9:00 a.m. at the Board of Supervisors Chambers of the Courthouse at 240 Church Street, Salinas, California.

B. <u>COMMENT PERIOD</u>

Jan Mitchell and Annemarie Tresh spoke regarding Rancho San Juan and notification.

C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES - No Minutes were scheduled for this meeting.

D. <u>SCHEDULED ITEMS</u>

1. HARPER CANYON REALTY LLC – PLN000696

Paul Mugan presented the project.

Michael Cling, appearing on behalf of the applicant, stated Keith Higgins and Ken Whitson were present to answer any questions. Mr. Cling gave highlights of the project, stated the description of the property should be 150 acres and not 180 acres that will be dedicated to Toro Park, and that dedication is not part of the project.

There was Committee discussion regarding what 150 acres of the 180 acres will be donated and what the use would be, and lessen or remove need for mitigation regarding park in lieu of fees.

Don Eshoff, Mary Ann Gennis, Rosa D'Acri, Susan Clark, Lowell Webster, Rose Marie Ray, Dean Rustad, Tony Lobay, Annemarie Tresch, Jan Mitchell, and Wylie Mitchell spoke in opposition of the project. Their concerns were CEQA, Mitigated Negative Declaration, requested Environmental Impact Report, sewer system, cumulative impacts, project description and remainder parcel, traffic impacts, pedestrian safety, water supply and quality, development on new parcels, tree removal, impact on school and public services, affordable housing, and development on 30% slopes.

The Committee discussed payment of fees prior to recordation of map, verify water issues, no EIR requested for traffic, cumulative information, impacts been mitigated correctly, concerned with 1994 subdivision access, remainder parcel, traffic issues, fees updated to current rates, private trail easement connecting Meyers Road with Toro Park, future building sites, ridgeline, slopes, potential visual impacts, drainage plan, and option for applicant to sign some sort of agreement to dedicate the 150 acres to Toro Park.

Lynn Burgess moved to continue the project to October 14, 2004, to gather information on the issues presented, James McPharlin seconded, and passed by the following vote:
