I am writing today because I am deeply concerned about the possibility of losing facilities and access to Stevenson School.

As the parent of a Stevenson student I am concerned that a major thoroughfare, Stevenson Dr., will be abandoned as part of the Pebble Beach Development Project. The closing of this route for residents will place the majority of traffic from the Hwy. 68 and Carmel gates directly past Stevenson School on Forest Lake Rd. making this the main artery to the country club area. As parents, we would like our children's learning environment to be as stress free and tranquil as possible. We have chosen Stevenson as a superior academic experience and do not appreciate the additional traffic and congestion to which our children would be exposed. It is our understanding that the closure of Stevenson Dr. is due to construction of yet another golf course.
