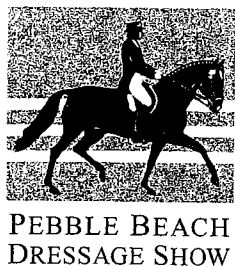

Thank you for taking time to read my letter. I have had the privilege of keeping horses at the Pebble Beach Equestrian Center for the last 25 years. The EIR has some issues that really weren't addressed by people who ride or own horses.

1. Weed-free hay is not available in our area & weed control issues are covered by other mitigations
2. Trails are used by hikers and Equestrians, some new trails are not designated for horses. We have worked hard over the years to maintain the Pebble Beach trails and improve them. Bicycles and motor bikes are prohibited by PBCO at this



time. Thank goodness. They are noisy & dangerous. But the EIR is silent on this issue.
