FINDINGS AND DECISION

In the matter of the application for **Lincoln Street Abandonment**:

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the County of Monterey has been asked to consider whether the abandonment of the public right-of-way over a portion of Lincoln Street in the community of Chualar is not inconsistent with the Central Salinas Valley Area Plan, a part of the Monterey County General Plan, said abandonment being approximately 300'± feet in length lying between Scott and Jackson Streets; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has discussed all pertinent issues related to the proposed abandonment including the data contained in the staff report dated September 25, 2002.

WHEREAS, the proposed abandonment is Categorically Exempt from CEQA;

DECISION

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the County of Monterey recommends to the Board of Supervisors that the proposed abandonment of the public right-of-way over a portion of Lincoln Street approximately 300'± feet in length is not inconsistent with the Central Salinas Valley Area Plan, a part of the Monterey County General Plan.
