FINDINGS AND DECISION

the community of Chualar is not inconsistent with the Central Salinas Valley Area Plan, a part of

the Monterey County General Plan, said abandonment being approximately 300'± feet in length

lying between Scott and Jackson Streets; and

proposed abandonment including the data contained in the staff report dated September 25, 2002.

WHEREAS, the proposed abandonment is Categorically Exempt from CEQA;

County of Monterey recommends to the Board of Supervisors that the proposed abandonment of

the public right-of-way over a portion of Lincoln Street approximately 300'± feet in length is not

inconsistent with the Central Salinas Valley Area Plan, a part of the Monterey County General

Plan.
