MONTANO. ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT.
PROJECT DESCRIPTION: USE PERMIT TO ALLOW AN ALTERATION TO A
CONTRIBUTING HISTORIC STRUCTURE IN AN HISTORIC RESOURCES
ZONING DISTRICT. THE ALTERATIONS CONSIST OF 1) THE DEMOLITION OF

PLANNING AREA: NORTH COUNTY NON-COASTAL. PROJECT PLANNER: TAVEN KINISON-BROWN. ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT PREPARED. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: CONTINUED FROM 1/14/09. REVISED CARLSEN ESTATES SUBDIVISION PROPOSAL (FINAL REVISION DATED 08/19/08; FIVE PLAN SHEETS WITH REVISIONS 10, 13, 12, 10, AND 11 RESPECTIVELY).
