RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission accept the applicant's withdrawal of this appeal.

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

This project was heard by the Monterey County Zoning Administrator (ZA) on June 14, 2007. The ZA approved the project subject to 26 conditions. On June 29, 2007, the applicants filed an appeal contesting Condition 11 as follows:

Applicant/Owner shall submit building plans illustrating that: 1. the redesign/relocation of the Caretaker Unit to avoid tree removal while providing one or two covered parking spaces; and 2. demonstrate with substantial evidence that the main single family residence cannot be moved or relocated to avoid tree removal. The building plans shall be reviewed and approved by the Director of the RMA - Planning Department and the Director of the RMA - Building Services Department.

Staff met with the applicant's representatives and has been able to resolve this matter. The applicant ahs agreed to revise the carport to retain one oak tree by the caretaker unit and has provided the necessary justification for removal of another oak tree by the main residence. As such, the condition has been met and no further action is necessary.
