#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission consider the following:

- 1) Reappointments. Requests for 26 LUAC member terms to be extended for two more years (**Exhibit A**).
- 2) Resignations.
  - a. Allow nine positions to be vacated (**Exhibit B**).
  - b. Remove two members who have changed residence and moved outside LUAC boundary (**Exhibit C**).
- 3) Options to eliminate or reorganize three Committees.

**PROJECT OVERVIEW:** Staff adjusted appointment dates in order to consolidate when appointments, reappointments, and resignations are considered. Staff has sent letters to LUAC members with the membership expiring June 30, 2009 (**Exhibit D**). Those that returned letters, their requests are identified. Where letters were not received back, staff followed up with email or some other form of communication. If no response was received, staff has presumed they did not request reappointment. These are included with the list of resignations for consideration.

As part of the annual report in March 2009, staff noted that three LUACs have had only three members whereas they are unable to meet without the minimum membership (at least five required). The following Neighborhood Design Review (NDRC) and Land Use Advisory Committees (LUAC) have not maintained minimum membership in 2009:

- 1) <u>Chualar Neighborhood Design Review Committee (NDRC)</u>. In 2009, there have been only three members. Two have terms expiring but only one has indicated a desire to continue. If that one term is extended, that would leave only 2 members, which is still short of the minimum five required.
- Spreckels Neighborhood Design Review Committee (NDRC). In 2009, there have been only three members. One has a term expiring and has indicated interest in continuing. An applicant recently submitted a project for consideration but there was insufficient membership to hear it. The Chairman says he has one potential member interested; however nothing has formally been submitted to the County. While not having the minimum membership, projects are forwarded to the Historic Resource Review Board (HRRB) and Spreckels DRB members are notified to attend the HRRB meeting.

3) <u>Cachagua Land Use Advisory Committee (LUAC)</u>. In 2009, there have been only three members. None have responded to requests from staff to extend their membership so now there will be zero members.

There has been no change and as a result not meetings have been held in these areas. The LUAC procedures require a minimum of members, which means there must be three members present to have a quorum.

Some options for the Planning Commission to consider include:

- Continue as is and continue to recruit for LUAC members. Staff would not schedule any items until there are at least five members.
- Direct staff to revise the procedures to allow a LUAC to have three members and be able to meet provided all three members attend. If all three attended, this would be similar to a quorum for a LUAC with the minimum five members.
- 3) Disband one or more the three LUACs that have not been able to establish the minimum membership.
- 4) Consolidate one LUAC with another and/or adjust boundaries for better attendance. For example:
  - (a) Create a Greater Salinas LUAC that incorporates Chualar and Spreckels with minimum membership of each existing LUAC.
  - (b) Combine Cachagua with Carmel Valley as they have the most similar issues to address
  - (c) Staff received a request to add the Bluffs development (located in Greater Salinas area where there is no LUAC representation) into the Toro LUAC.
