

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends that the Planning Commission:


- 1) Receive a report on General Plan policies that have been flagged by the Planning Commission;
- 2) Consider schedule for continued review of the draft General Plan; and
- 3) Continue the public hearing to July 14, 2010 for further consideration of the Project.

**DISCUSSION:**

On March 31, 2010, the Commission began working through the General Plan and flagging matters that are to return for further discussion. On June 6<sup>th</sup>, the Commission completed an initial review, and staff indicated that we would present responses to the flagged items. At the June 30<sup>th</sup> meeting, staff will report on the status of the flagged items and present a report at the meeting if all of the flagged items are completed. Staff recommends continuing the item to July 14 to begin review of the flagged items. The Commission may wish to consider a schedule for completing this next phase including preparation of the Commission recommendation to the Board of Supervisors.
